Champaign Area USBC Youth - Adult/Child Tournament

Rules

1. This tournament will be certified and conducted under the playing rules of USBC, including Rule 400. This is a doubles tournament and each doubles team will consist of one youth bowler (who is currently a member of the Champaign Area USBC Youth) and one adult bowler (18 years of age or older and not competing in youth leagues). **All adult bowlers who are not current USBC members will pay a participation fee of \$5.00.**
2. Divisions are as follows: Division A – Bantam Division B – Prep Division C – Junior/Major/Senior
3. **Entries close 30 minutes prior to squad time, providing there is space available. All walk-in entries will be subject to a \$5 late fee. All late fees will be put toward scholarships.**
4. All bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to the start of bowling.
5. Multiple participation is allowed, provided you bowl with another person. In no case shall the youth bowler be permitted to place more than once in the prize list for position standings, trophy, and/or scholarship.
6. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the combined bowlers' averages and 420.
7. Handicap
Youth Bowler: will be figured on the youth bowler's highest sanctioned league average as of February 15, 2010, based on 21 or more games in that league.
Adult Bowler: Adult bowler will use their highest CA USBC Yearbook average for 2008-2009 (21 game minimum). If the adult bowler does not have a qualifying 2008-09 CA USBC Yearbook average, they will use their highest current average as of February 15, 2010 (21 game minimum). Adult bowlers without any of the aforementioned averages may pay a participation fee of \$5 and will be assigned an average, 130 for women and 160 for men. USBC adult bowlers will be subject to all provisions of Rule 319a-e.
8. Bowling will consist of 3 games for each bowler on one pair of lanes. The youth and adult scores will be added together and handicap added to determine total pins for the doubles team.
9. Bowling will begin in accordance with the arranged schedule. Bowlers who arrive late will begin play with the frame being bowled.
10. Trophies will be awarded on the basis of total pins plus handicap. Trophies will be awarded in each division at a ratio of one in ten.
11. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of total pins plus handicap. A minimum \$50 scholarship will be awarded to the 1st place youth bowler in each division. Additional scholarships may be awarded, depending on the number of entries in the tournament. All scholarship monies will be deposited in the SMART program, Account 9089, 621 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, TX 76011; phone 1-800-514-2695, ext. 3168.
12. Entry fees are to be paid with the entry form. No fees will be refunded after bowling has been scheduled.
13. Bowlers will receive 10 minutes of practice balls prior to the beginning of competition.
14. Any appeal or protest shall be made to the Tournament Committee within 72 hours. The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless advised within 48 hours of an appeal to USBC.
15. In case of a tie for first place in any division, there will be a one game roll-off to determine the winner.
16. There will be no eating or drinking in the bowler's area during tournament play. No use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or drugs, etc. will be permitted during the tournament.
17. Only participants and tournament officials are permitted in the bowler's area.
18. Total entry fee is \$10.00 per bowler. (Lineage for 3 games, \$6.00; awards fee \$2.00; expense fee, \$2.00)
19. The entire awards fee collected will be returned 100% in the form of trophies and scholarships.
