TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is USBC certified. **ELIGIBILITY:** Any current youth member of the CHAMPAIGN AREA USBC ASSOCIATION who has bowled at least 6 games as of January 20, 2010 in a certified youth league at a center within the boundaries of the CHAMPAIGN AREA USBC YOUTH is eligible to bowl.
2. This is a handicap only tournament. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 210. The bowler's average, for handicapping purposes, will be the higher of the 2008-2009 CA USBC yearbook average (21 or more games) and the bowler's current average as of February 1, 2010 (21 games minimum). Eligible bowlers not having a minimum of 21 games as of February 1, 2010, shall use their 2008-2009 yearbook average; all others shall bowl scratch.
3. All entry fees must be paid prior to bowling. The closing date will be 30 minutes prior to the starting time of the qualifying squad. Walk-in (not prepaid) entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes before the posted starting time, space permitting. All walk-in entries will be subject to a \$5 late fee.
4. Subs will be allowed, but must be on hand at the proper starting time. A bowler entering before the start of qualifying, as a sub, does in fact become the original entrant and is entitled to remain in the tournament as long as he/she is able.
5. Emergency substitutions will be allowed with the following stipulations: the tenth qualifying team will replace the withdrawing team. If an additional sub is needed, the tournament committee will continue down the standings list until a replacement is located within the bowling center.
6. All prizes will be paid to the bowler in the form of scholarships and administered by the SMART Program, Account 9089, 621 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, TX 76011 / 1-800-514-2695, ext. 3168
7. Prize fee(s) will be returned 100% and at a ratio of one in ten entries.
8. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entrant prior to the scheduled time of bowling or at any time later in the tournament should an entrant be discovered ineligible to compete. Any entrant so rejected after beginning to bowl shall forfeit all entry fees and prize money. The committee shall remove from the lanes, after one warning, any entrant, who in the judgment of the committee is guilty of misconduct.
9. In case of a breakdown, the tournament committee reserves the right to move the bowlers to an alternate pair of lanes. If moved, each bowler will be allowed ONE practice ball (no re-racks) on each of the alternate lanes.
10. Tournament management shall be the Youth Committee of the CHAMPAIGN AREA USBC ASSOCIATION.
11. USBC rules shall govern any situation not covered by the above.
12. The tournament format will be as listed below. All squads will start on time unless held up by delays beyond the control of the Tournament Committee. Any bowler arriving late for any squad will receive 0 for any frames missed. In case of ties during match play, positions as the computer places the bowlers will be final. In the case of a tie for the last qualifying spot, a one game roll-off will be held between the tied parties prior to the beginning of the finals.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

All bowling will be at WESTERN BOWL in Champaign, Illinois. Qualifying will be on February 20, 2010 at 1:00 PM. Qualifying will consist of bowling three (3) games on one pair of lanes. The nine (9) highest scoring teams (with handicap) will advance to the finals. If a tie for the ninth spot should occur, a one game roll-off will be bowled to break the tie (handicap included).

Finals will consist of a round robin of two game matches, with each team bowling two other teams on the same pair of lanes at the same time. Teams will rotate one pair to the right for the second game of the match. The Finals will begin on February 20, 2010, approximately 30 minutes after qualifying has ended and will consist of the first two rounds. The finals will continue on February 21, 2010, beginning at 11 AM with the remaining three rounds.

Champions will be determined on a point system. Each team will be awarded 50 bonus pins for each game and series won from each team in each match (handicap included). Total pinfall plus total bonus pins will determine the champions. Qualifying pinfall carries over into the finals. Should a tie for the championship occur, a two game roll-off will be bowled across the same lanes used for the finals with the same point system determining the winner. Ties for other places will split the combined prize money for the respective places.
