TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is United States Bowling Congress(USBC) sanctioned. Any current youth member of the USBC and Champaign Area USBC who has bowled at least 6 games in a sanctioned youth league at a center within the boundaries of the Champaign Area USBC is eligible to bowl.
2. This is a handicap tournament. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220. The bowler's average, for handicapping purposes, will be the higher of the 2010-2011 Champaign Area USBC yearbook average (21 or more games) and the bowler's current average as of November 26, 2011 (6 games minimum). Any bowler not having a minimum of 6 games as of November 26, 2011, shall use their 2010-2011 yearbook average; all others shall bowl scratch.
3. All entry fees must be paid prior to bowling. Entries close 30 minutes prior to the qualifying squad time, providing there is space available. All walk-in entries will be subject to a \$5 late fee.
4. Lane assignments will be assigned by the tournament officials based on size of squad.
5. All prizes shall be in the form of scholarships and administered by the USBC SMART Program, 621 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, Texas, 76011, Account #9089. Prize fee(s) will be returned 100% and at a ratio of one in ten entries.
6. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entrant prior to the scheduled time of bowling or at any time later in the tournament should an entrant be discovered ineligible to compete. Any entrant so rejected after beginning to bowl shall forfeit all entry fees and prize money. The committee shall remove from the lanes, after one warning, any entrant, who in the judgment of the committee is guilty of misconduct.
7. In case of a breakdown, the tournament committee reserves the right to move the bowlers to an alternate pair of lanes. If moved, each bowler will be allowed ONE practice ball (no re-racks) on each of the alternate lanes.
8. Tournament management will be the Youth Committee of the Champaign Area USBC Association.
9. USBC rules shall govern any situation not covered by the above.
10. The tournament format will be as listed below. All squads will start on time unless held up by delays beyond the control of the Tournament Committee. Any bowler arriving late for any squad will receive 0 for any frames missed. In case of ties during match play, positions as the computer places the bowlers will be final. In the case of a tie for the last qualifying spot, a one game roll-off will be held between the tied parties prior to the beginning of the finals.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

All bowling will be at Country Tyme in Rantoul, Illinois. Qualifying will be on December 3, 2011 at 1:00 PM. Qualifying will consist of bowling FOUR (4) games moving one pair to the right after each game. The eight (8) highest scoring bowlers will advance to the finals. If a tie for the eighth spot should occur, a one-frame roll-off will be bowled to break the tie (handicap included). The Finals will begin immediately after the completion of qualifying.

Finals will consist of a round robin of one game matches, with each entrant bowling one other entrant on the same pair of lanes at the same time. Bowlers will receive lane assignments before the 1st ball of finals is thrown. The Finals will begin on December 3, 2011, immediately after qualifying has ended, and will consist of the first two (2) rounds. The Finals will continue on December 4, 2011, beginning at 12 NOON with the remaining six (6) rounds.

Champions will be determined on a point system. Each entrant will be awarded 50 bonus pins for each match won. Total pin-fall plus total bonus pins will determine the champion of each division. Qualifying pin-fall carries over into the finals. Should a tie for the championship occur, a one game roll-off will be bowled across the same lanes used for the finals with the same point system determining the winner. Ties for other places will split the combined prize money for the respective places.
