## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

Bowlers must be a member of the Champaign Area USBC and have bowled at least 3 games in a league within the Champaign Area USBC before January 1, 2012.

This is a scratch tournament and is open to men or women.

## **QUALIFYING**

Qualifying will be held at Arrowhead Lanes on February 11, 2012 at 2:00 p.m.

Bowlers will draw for their starting lane before their squad starts.

Bowlers will bowl nine games in qualifying across nine pair of lanes.

After qualifying the field will be cut in half and these bowlers will bowl six games in the semi-finals on Sunday.

The field will then be cut to the top nine bowlers based on total pinfall. These bowlers will bowl the finals the following weekend at Western Bowl.

In the case of a tie for the 9<sup>th</sup> spot, a one game roll-off will be bowled.

## **SEMI-FINALS**

Semi-finals will be held at Arrowhead Lanes on February 12, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.

Bowlers will be paired by total pinfall in qualifying and will be six games across six pair of lanes.

All bowlers in the semi-finals will pay \$12.00 for lineage before bowling begins.

All pins in qualifying and semi-finals will carry over to the finals.

## **FINALS**

The finals will be bowled at Western Bowl on February 18, 2012 and February 19, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.

The finals will consist of 9 bowlers bowling each other in a round robin format, consisting of five matches of three games. Each bowler will be bowling against two other bowlers in each round. The first and last rounds will be position rounds. Bowlers will move one pair to the right after each game. Bowlers will receive 50 bonus points for each bowler they defeat each game and series on their pair of lanes. The championship will be decided by combining total pins bowled and total bonus points won. Should a tie occur for first place, a one game roll-off will be bowled on the middle pair of lanes used in the finals to determine the champion. Should there still be a tie, a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame will be bowled.

Three matches will be bowled on Saturday, and the final two will be bowled on Sunday.

The lineage in the finals will be paid from the prize fund.

Substitute bowlers are allowed but they must be a bowler that was eliminated from the qualifying round. A substitute bowler entering the finals after the start of the first round will have 400 points deducted from their score. This deduction will be taken at the time the substitute enters the finals. Once a bowler is replaced by a substitute they cannot return to the tournament. The bowler who finishes the tournament shall receive the prize money.

There will be a \$30 charge for any returned check and that bowler will be turned in to USBC.

All prize money will be returned 100% (minus lineage) at a ratio of 1 prize for every 5 entries.
